

Privacy Policy

This privacy statement applies to the Rally Foundation with respect to the privacy of our online visitors and donors.

Rally Foundation does not collect personally identifiable information without permission. This site collects contact information when you donate or register. In such cases, Rally Foundation will need personal information such as name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, and credit card number, in order to register your participation, process your donation, and/or provide a receipt. We may use the information you provide to send you information about event results, how proceeds are being distributed and other Rally Foundation related promotions.

Our website has security measures in place to protect against the loss, misuse or alteration of the information under our control. Our web server is located in a locked, secure environment. All databases containing personal information are securely stored on a separate system.

When you visit our Web site, our statistic report automatically generates anonymous information about our site visitors. The statistical report collects data on each visitor's type of computer, browser, and ISP (internet service provider). It also records the date, time, and pages visited. Collecting this information helps us design the site to suit your needs.

Mainly, our concern is how many visits the site is getting, from where they are being referred, and which pages are viewed most often.

Our server is encrypted to protect credit card and other information submitted via the forms on this site. Rally Foundation follows the Association of Fundraising Professional's (AFP) Ethical Guidelines to the Code of Ethical Principles and Standards of Professional Practice.

To protect your privacy, Rally Foundation does not sell, rent, exchange or otherwise share information about donors, volunteers or other participants with any other organization or individual.
